
- Please read this user manual carefully before using the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot and make sure you keep these instructions so you can refer to them later. If you do not follow the instructions as given here, this may endanger the safety of your child.

WARNING

- This product is suitable only for a child who is still unable to sit without help.
- Never leave your child unattended.
- Do not let other children play unsupervised near to the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot.
- Never use the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot on a stand or support.
- Use mattresses with a maximum thickness of 15 mm.
- Only use the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot on surfaces that are stable, level and dry.
- Do not use the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot if parts are broken or ripped, or parts are missing.
- Only replacement parts supplied or recommended by CONCORD shall be used.
- Please be aware of the risks presented by open flames and other sources of heat – such as electrical heating equipment, gas fires, etc. – if these are located in the immediate vicinity of the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot.
- Please ensure you regularly check the carry straps, attachment straps and the floor of the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot for signs of damage or wear and tear.
- Dispose of all plastic packaging immediately. It can present a life-threatening hazard for children.
- While the stroller is being used, the carrying handles of the CONCORD SNUG shall be left out of the product.

FITTING THE CONCORD SNUG SOFT CARRY-COT

The CONCORD WANDERER's seat unit must be installed facing away from the direction of travel when the CONCORD SNUG is used.





Remove the safety bar and then move the backrest on the CONCORD WANDERER to the horizontal (flat) position.

Undo the velcro fasteners on the cover in the foot area.

Undo the press studs on the attachment straps (04). Place the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot into the CONCORD WANDERER, lining up the cot's foot area with the seat unit's foot area.



Guide the attachment straps (04) in the foot area between the stroller tube frame and cover, and then close the press studs on the attachment straps.




Guide the attachment straps (04) in the head area over the tube frame and secure these to the press studs on the stroller's cover.

To give the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot some additional stability, move the stroller's footrest to the upright position.

Please also follow the instructions included with the CONCORD WANDERER.

WARNING

- Before use, always make sure that the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot is properly attached all round.




WARNING

- When not using the CONCORD SNUG, do up the velcro fasteners on the cover of the foot rest on the CONCORD WANDERER.

_ OPENING THE FOOT AREA

To open the foot area, unzip the zip fasteners (03) on the left and right sides of the CONCORD SNUG to the desired position and then fold down the upper part of the foot area (01).



_ USE AS FOOT MUFF

The CONCORD SNUG can be used as a foot muff when it is not being used as a soft carry-cot. The floor plate must be removed from the carry-cot on the underside and the harness system of the CONCORD WANDERER must be guided through the openings provided on the underside of the CONCORD SNUG and on the mattress.

WARNING

- Before use, always check that the harness system has been correctly installed and adjusted.
- Always use the harness system when you are using the CONCORD SNUG as a foot muff.
- Please follow the instructions included with the CONCORD WANDERER.
- If you are not using the CONCORD SNUG as a foot muff, put the foot plate back into the carry-cot on the underside.

_ CLEANING INFORMATION

If the CONCORD SNUG Soft Carry-cot is only slightly dirty, then you can simply use a soft brush or damp cloth to clean the cot. You can wash your CONCORD SNUG to remove heavy soiling. Before washing the cot, make sure you remove the mattress and the floor plate from the bag on the underside.

- The cover material colour may run slightly when wet, in particular during washing.
- Do not use solvents on the cover!



Leave the cover to dry completely after washing. Then replace the floor plate in the bag on the underside and put the mattress back into the CONCORD SNUG.

GUARANTEE

The guarantee begins on the day of purchase. The guarantee period corresponds to the statutory warranty period in the end-user's country concerned. At the manufacturer's discretion, the guarantee shall cover rectification, replacement or a price reduction.

The guarantee is valid for the original purchaser only. In the event of any defect, claims can not be considered unless the specialist dealer is notified of the fault as soon as it occurs for the first time. If the specialist dealer is unable to remedy the problem himself, he must return the product to the manufacturers together with details of the complaint, official proof of purchase and the purchase date. The manufacturers assume no liability for faulty goods that they did not supply.

The guarantee does not apply where:

- the product has been modified;
- the product is not brought back to the specialist dealer complete with proof of purchase within 14 days of the defect occurring;
- the defect was caused by improper usage or maintenance or due to anything else deemed to be the fault of the user, in particular failure to comply with the instructions for use;
- repairs have been carried out on the product by third parties;
- the defect was caused as the result of an accident.
- the serial number has been damaged or removed

The guarantee makes no provision for any alteration or deterioration to the product that is incurred through normal usage (wear and tear). The period of guarantee shall not be extended by any remedial measures carried out by the manufacturers in the event of a claim.
